If it is on this side, the % is less than average

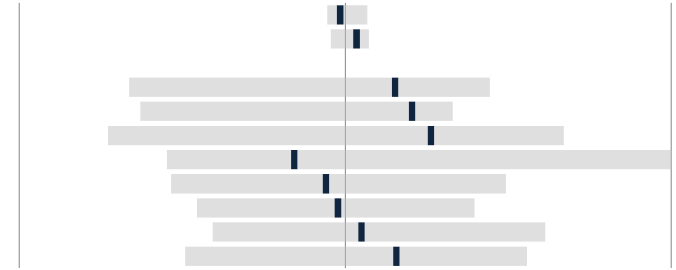
The line down the centre is the B&NES average
