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Comparison Graph - This graph compares the local area to B&NES

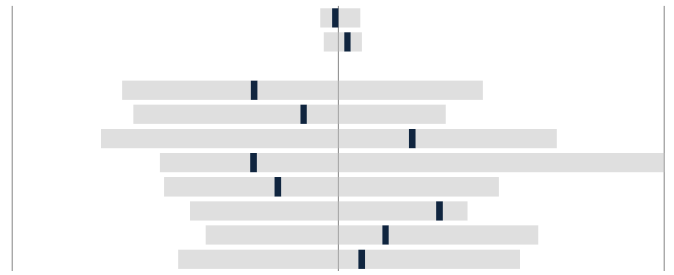
The dark line represents this local area
