

Community Meals – Alternative Options

If you're experiencing health problems and are struggling to get out to the shops or prepare healthy meals for yourself at home, there will be ways in which you can overcome these difficulties.

We have provided some suggestions on how you can continue to have a prepared meal even if you find it hard to get out and about and able to prepare a meal for yourself and you're able to use an oven or microwave, you could consider buying ready meals.

You could also arrange for a care worker to come in and prepare meals through a private home care agency (we recommend using one which is registered and inspected by the Care Quality Commission).

SUPERMARKET READY MEALS

Nearly all of the supermarkets big or small will have ready meals available and most have an on-line ordering system which a friend or relative could put in place for you.

HOME SUPPORT MEALS

Support can be provided with meal preparation as part of an assessed need.

DINING/DAY CENTRES
