- We have five rooms available for our own use or for hire. All have free wi-fi and some have their own PA systems, hearing loops.
- A projector and screen are also available. There's a lift to provide disabled access to the upstairs rooms



- ❑ Our Main Hall can seat up to 252 people in theatre style rows, or 160 for seating at tables. It has a full stage complete with a fly tower.



The objects of the SCA are:

- To promote recreation and leisure-time activities such that it has a positive influence on the community.
- To bring together the Saltford community and local authorities, voluntary and other organisations to advance education and to provide facilities in the interests of social and community welfare.

Six Trustees, four part-time employees and a Management Committee of 23, which meets six times a year

Some of the regular SCA activities at the Hall are: *Christmas Fairs, Badminton, Short Mat Bowling, Sequence & Old Time Dancing, Drama & Musical Presentations, Flea Markets, Choral and Orchestral Concerts, Community Cinema, Computer Cafés, Society and Club meetings etc*



Salford Community Cinema



Following the successful launch last year, we have been showing a series of films some of which have been attended by over 100. These are going to continue throughout 2017.

Unless stated otherwise, the doors will open at 6.45pm with the film screening from 7.30pm. A fully licensed bar will be available together with ice cream.

As a Charity, we rely heavily on a large band of enthusiastic volunteers, to whom we are immensely grateful.

We receive a limited amount of funding from the Parish Council, from BANES Ward Councillors' Initiative and from some other bodies, but for most of our income we depend strongly on fundraising events and on charges for external hiring.

External hirers use our rooms for a huge range of meetings, for example, antique markets, parties, musical events and weddings.



Saltford Village Festival

Held every two years in June since 2011.

Nine days of events, from drama and music productions, photo and poetry competitions, flea market, lectures, films, tea parties.

Includes an **Old Village Day**, during which part of the High Street is closed to traffic for the erection of about 40 stalls. Events include childrens' games, street parties, dog show, car show, pottery, Morris and medieval dancing, jazz and swing bands, river events.
