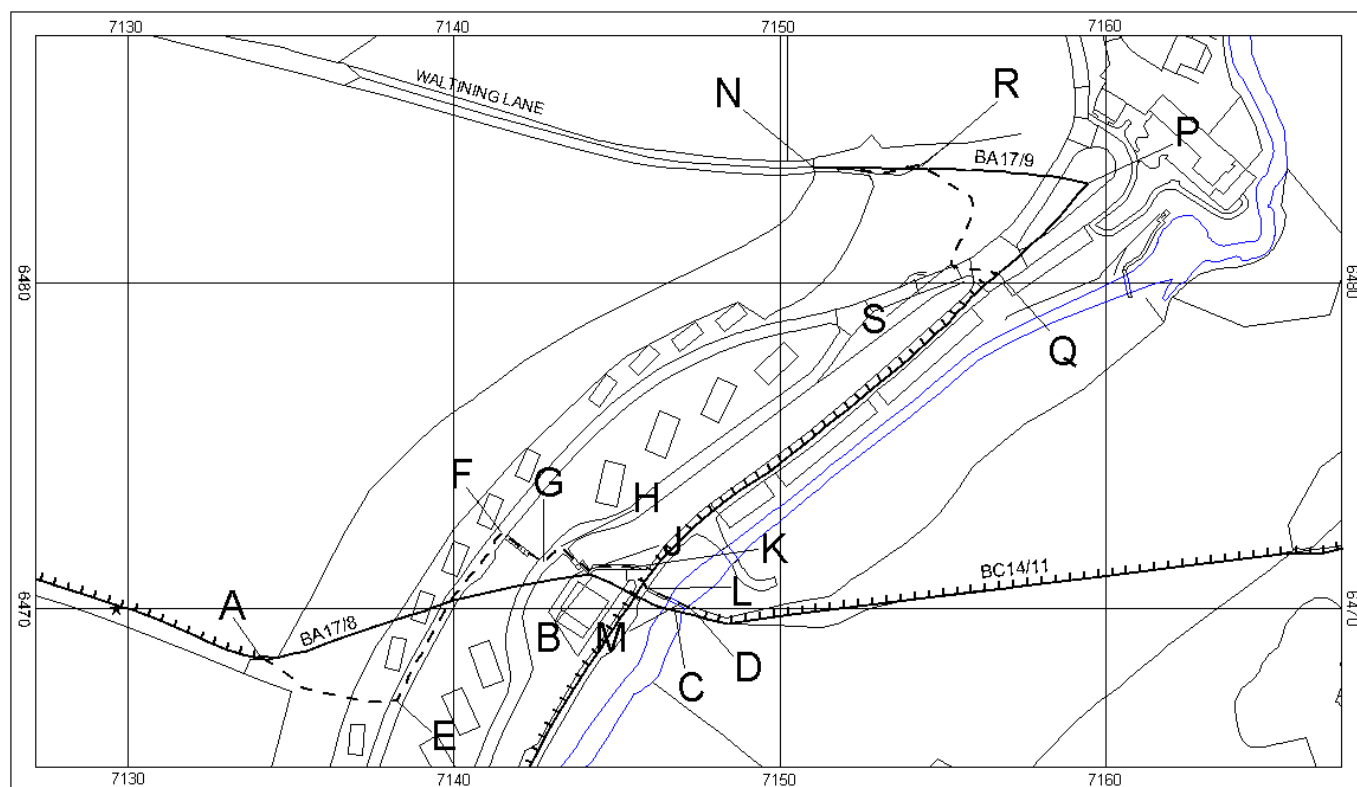


FOR THE ATTENTION OF ALL PUBLIC FOOTPATH USERS

The general effect of the proposal is shown on the above plan.

The section of FP BA17/8 commencing from grid reference ST 7134 6468 at point A on the plan and proceeding in a generally easterly direction to point D, via points B & C, would be stopped up, as shown by a continuous black line. The new line of FP BA17/8 would commence from point A and proceed in a generally easterly direction to point D, via points E, F, G, H, J, K L & M, as shown by a dashed black line.

The section of FP BA17/9 commencing from grid reference ST 7151 6483 at point N on the plan and proceeding in a generally east south-easterly direction to point Q, via point P, would be stopped up, as shown by a continuous black line. The new line of FP BA17/9 would commence from point N and proceed in a generally east south-easterly direction to point Q, via points R & S, as shown by a dashed black line.

These changes are proposed in the interests of the relevant landowner, by recording the routes that have been walked by the public since the land was first landscaped by a previous owner more than 40 years ago.

The changes would be achieved by way of a diversion order made under section 119 Highways Act 1980. The new path would be created without any limitations.
