

**Order of Bath Magistrates' Court for stopping up of a highway**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 116**

Before the Bath Magistrates Court sitting at North Parade Road, Bath, BA1 5AF **NOTICE** having been given by Maria Lucas, Head of Legal and Democratic Services, Bath and North East Somerset Council, Lewis House, Manvers Street, Bath BA1 1JG of an order under Section 116 of the Highways Act 1980 for the stopping up of portions of public highways situated within the district and the county of Bath and North East Somerset namely a portion of the unnamed lane leading from Zion Place to Crossways and a portion of Flatts Lane in Farmborough which are represented by red cross-hatching on the plan attached to this Order.

**AND THE COURT** being satisfied that the said Council has given the Notices required by Part 1 of Schedule 12 to the Highways Act 1980 and the Court being satisfied that the portions of public highways are unnecessary.

**IT IS ORDERED** that:

- the portion of the unnamed lane leading from Zion Place to Crossways in Farmborough totalling approximately 194m<sup>2</sup> centred on grid reference ST 6453 5963 and shown cross-hatched in red and labelled A on the attached plan be stopped up;
- the portion of Flatts Lane in Farmborough totalling approximately 17m<sup>2</sup> centred on grid reference ST 6453 5964 and shown cross-hatched in red and labelled B on the attached plan be stopped up.

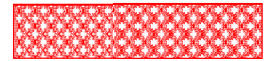

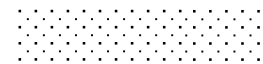
**Unnamed lane leading from Zion Place to Crossways and Flatts Lane, Farmborough**
