HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 - SECTION 116

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO APPLY FOR AN ORDER FOR STOPPING UP PORTIONS OF PIXASH LANE AND STIDHAM FARM LANE, KEYNSHAM

NOTICE is given that the Bath and North East Somerset Council (“the Authority”) intends to apply to Bath Magistrates Court sitting at North Parade Road, Bath, BA1 5AF on Thursday 1st November 2018 at 2.00pm for an order that public rights over portions of the public highways known as Pixash Lane and Stidham Farm Lane, Keynsham described in the Schedule to this Notice shall be stopped up under section 116 of the Highways Act 1980 on the ground that they are unnecessary.

The effect of the Order if granted will be to stop up all public highway rights over the land described in Part I of the Schedule and to stop up all public highway rights subject to the reservation of a public footpath over the land described in Part II of the Schedule, except where immediately before the date of the Order there is apparatus of statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across the public highway to be stopped up pursuant to this Order then, subject to the provisions of Part II of Schedule 12 of the Highways Act 1980 those undertakers shall have the same rights as respects that apparatus after that public highway is stopped up as they had immediately beforehand over the land described in the Schedule. On the hearing of the application the Authority, any person to whom notice is required to be given, any person who uses the public highway and any other person who would be aggrieved by the making of the Order applied for, has a right to be heard.

SCHEDULE

Part I

The portion of Pixash Lane in Keynsham commencing from a junction with Stidham Lane at grid reference ST 6712 6846 (Point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally northerly direction through Avon Valley Adventure and Wildlife Park for approximately 240 metres to grid reference ST 6714 6870 (Point B on the Order Plan) and shown cross-hatched in red on the Order Plan.

The portion of Stidham Farm Lane in Keynsham totalling approximately 52m² centred on grid reference ST 6728 6838 (Point C on the Order Plan) and shown cross-hatched in red the Order Plan.

Part II

The portion of Stidham Farm Lane commences from a junction with Pixash Lane at grid reference ST 6712 6845 (Point D on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally east-south-easterly direction for approximately 465 metres to a junction with public footpath BA27/41 at grid reference ST 6754 6835 (Point E on the Order Plan) and shown hatched in green on the Order Plan.

The Order Plan may be inspected free of charge at The One Stop Shop, Market Walk, Keynsham, BS31 1FS during normal office hours.
