

**BATH MAGISTRATES' COURT**

**MATTER OF COMPLAINT:**

DATED this 5 September 2018

THIS COMPLAINT is laid by Bath and North East Somerset Council (the Highway Authority) to the Bath Magistrates' Court for the stopping up under section 116 of the Highways Act 1980 of portions of the highway at Pixash Lane and Stidham Farm Lane, Keynsham which are indicated by red cross-hatching and green hatching on the attached plan, on the ground that they are unnecessary.

The effect of the Order sought will be to:

- stop up all public highway rights over the portion of Pixash Lane in Keynsham commencing from a junction with Stidham Lane at grid reference ST 6712 6846 (Point A on the Plan) and proceeding in a generally northerly direction through Avon Valley Adventure and Wildlife Park for approximately 240 metres to grid reference ST 6714 6870 (Point B on the Plan) and shown cross-hatched in red on the attached plan;
- stop up all public highway rights over the portion of Stidham Farm Lane in Keynsham totalling approximately 52m<sup>2</sup> centred on grid reference ST 6728 6838 (Point C on the Plan) and shown cross-hatched in red on the attached plan;
- stop up all public highway rights subject to the reservation of a public footpath over the portion of Stidham Farm Lane commencing from a junction with Pixash Lane at grid reference ST 6712 6845 (Point D on the Plan) and proceeding in a generally east-south-easterly direction for approximately 465 metres to a junction with public footpath BA27/41 at grid reference ST 6754 6835 (Point E on the Plan) and shown cross-hatched in green on the attached plan.

The application will be made on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2018 at 2.00 p.m. at the Bath Magistrates' Court.
