- 1. This Statement of Case is made by myself, Edward Lippiatt, and is submitted in support of the Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order issued by Bath and North East Somerset Council on July 18th 2017. The DMMO seeks to record a Restricted Byway between St Catherine Lane at grid reference ST 7611 7106, along an existing track in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 200m, to the border with South Gloucestershire at grid reference ST 7624 7121.
- I am a local farmer and was born on the farm in 1967, my father was born on the farm in 1944, he has used the route all his life uptill 2012
- 3. I have used the route on foot from an early age
- 4. I have used the route on horseback in my childhood in the 70s
- 5. I have used the route on bicycle in my childhood in the 70s
- 6. I have used the route by motorised vehicle as a child to go to school in Marshfield, then I used to take my children to school using this route if the A46 was busy. I also used it back from friends houses in Marshfield. We used to use the route to access Beeks Farm with a tractor and trailer to collect barley, now I have to make a 5mile detour.

- 7. Prior to 2012 I did not see any private signs or notices on or near the route that discouraged or encouraged me to use it.
- 8. No one has ever attempted to turn me back or said that I have no right to use the route.
- I have never been given permission to use the route. This was historically allowed for the local residents of the valley
- 10. I have never met the landowner, their employees or family while I was using the route.
- 11. Before 2012 there was never any obstruction on the route. Use of the track was barred after 2012 by padlocked gates and private signs at both ends, causing considerable inconvenience to everyone.

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
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Úser Evidence Form Plan

Witness Statement of Edward J Lippiatt

I, Edward Lippiatt of Henly Tyning Farm St Catherines Bath BA1 8HQ wish to make the following statements concerning the gravel track between Leigh Lane and Beeks Mill;

- 1) I have lived in the valley all of my life, 48 years. I farm about 630 acres in the St Catherines Valley.
- 2) In all these years the gravel track has only been used by locals (My family, Harpers and Godwins) and the postman, on an infrequent basis, because it has been and still is very rutted.
- We had a 'gentlemans agreement' to use the track with the previous owners of Beeks Mill, cutting the hedges in return.
- 4) As far back as I can remember there has always been a gate against Leigh Lane, that was usually shut and had a private/no access sign. Also please shut the gate, as it normally was.
- 5) Walkers and horses used the gravel track. The previous owners used to stop vehicles and made them turn around.
- We only use the track for access to Beeks Farm and Beeks Mill.

 Rarely do we use it to go to Marshfield.
- 7) The worry is if it is upgraded to a public highway, cars and more worryingly lorries will try and use it when the A46 is shut. These lanes are not suitable for any more traffic, and they will get stuck or cause accidents.
