## Royal Victoria Park Main area

Bath's principal park containing the exceptional Botanical Gardens

This beautiful park has wide open spaces which include some fine ornaments and wonderful bedding displays. It is in one of the most popular parts of Bath.

Entrance to this walk is through the main gateway and past the Victorian Obelisk. The Serpentine lake is fed by springs piped from the hills above Bath. The park contains the beautiful Botanical Gardens, and a popular children's play area and skateboard park. Opposite the top entrance to the Botanical Gardens is the Great Dell created from disused stone quarries, planted with pines to create a romantic landscape.

The walk returns across Middle Common which did not become part of the park until 1879.
