1. Bathwick Street entrance. Enhanced threshold and new removable bollards.
  2. Sydney Place (west) frontage. New Petanque terrain, railings to boundary wall and boundary planting.
  3. Seating space at Bathwick Street entrance. Tree for Climate Change.
  4. Improved setting to Gardener's Lodge with new planting and circulation space.
  5. Space at building cluster with improved access.
  6. Lower tennis courts. Refurbished to LTA standards. Layout reconfigured to 2No courts.
  7. Play landscape. Natural play theme zoned by age groups, with improved accessibility.
  8. Plaza space to complement Cafe.
  9. Labyrinth. Based on original Georgian layout, formed with low earth-filled hazel hurdle banks and planted with grasses.
  10. Railway path. Improved surfacing and steps.
  11. Extension of evergreen shrub edge to strengthen containment of lawn and inhibit desire line to play area.
  12. Connection to Holburne Museum.
  13. Clearing created at historic location of orchestra bandstand, new power supply.
  14. 'Ruin garden' setting to the Ruin. Area reclaimed from depot for public use, with improved access and ornamental planting. New swing for 'grown-ups'.
  15. Long seat restored and reconstructed. Macadam removed to create new lawn.
  16. Sydney Place (south) entrance. Minor repairs to entrance, gate overthrow and wall. New railings to boundary wall and new tree planting. Path improved.
  17. Train viewing area. Improved path surfacing and new seating/ viewing opportunities. Network Rail railing to existing balustrade.
  18. Labyrinth. Interpretation of remnant footprint at original location.
  19. Canal tow path entrance. New ramped access and improved steps. Minor repairs to walls and ironwork.
  20. Sydney Road entrance. Enhanced threshold and new removable bollards.
  21. Raised beds as herb garden for use by community and organised groups.
  22. Upper tennis courts. Refurbished to LTA standards.
  23. Seating and vantage points for long-distance views.
  24. North eastern entrance. Reconfigured and widened steps. Improved paths.
  25. Dementia-friendly route, with focal seating, improved access and seating opportunities, and sensory planting.
  26. Former allotment. Reclaimed into the public Gardens with new paths, orchard and fitness trim trail.
  27. Beckford Road (north) entrance. Reopened for continuous public access, enhanced threshold and gateway improved.
  28. New gate in existing opening.
  29. New gated access to rear of Cafe.
