NOTES: ♦ - Between 0900 and 1600 service 42 operates a flexible service in Southdown, Twerton and Whiteway for pre-booked passengers. Service 42 is operated by clean, quick, modern and comfortable buses. The vehicles are low-floor and easily accessible for wheelchair users, and have room for buggies.

Park & Ride to city centre

- **Odd Down to St James's Parade** – Park & Ride service 41 runs between Odd Down and St James's Parade on Mondays to Saturdays from 0615 until 2030, and on Sundays and most Public Holidays from 0930 to 1800.

Services operate every 12-15 minutes throughout the day.

- For customers travelling on to the City Centre or returning late from the RUH then return tickets bought on service 42 can be used to return to the Park & Ride site on service 41.

- **Newbridge and Lansdown** – Park & Ride services also operate into Bath from sites at Lansdown (to the North) and Newbridge (to the West); to a similar timetable.

Fares

- Single - £2
- Return - £3
- Ten single journeys (use any time) - £13

English National Concessionary pass holders travel free (except before 0900 Mondays to Fridays).

Accompanied children under 16 go free (max. five children per adult farepayer or concessionary pass holder).

Park for free, pay on the bus.

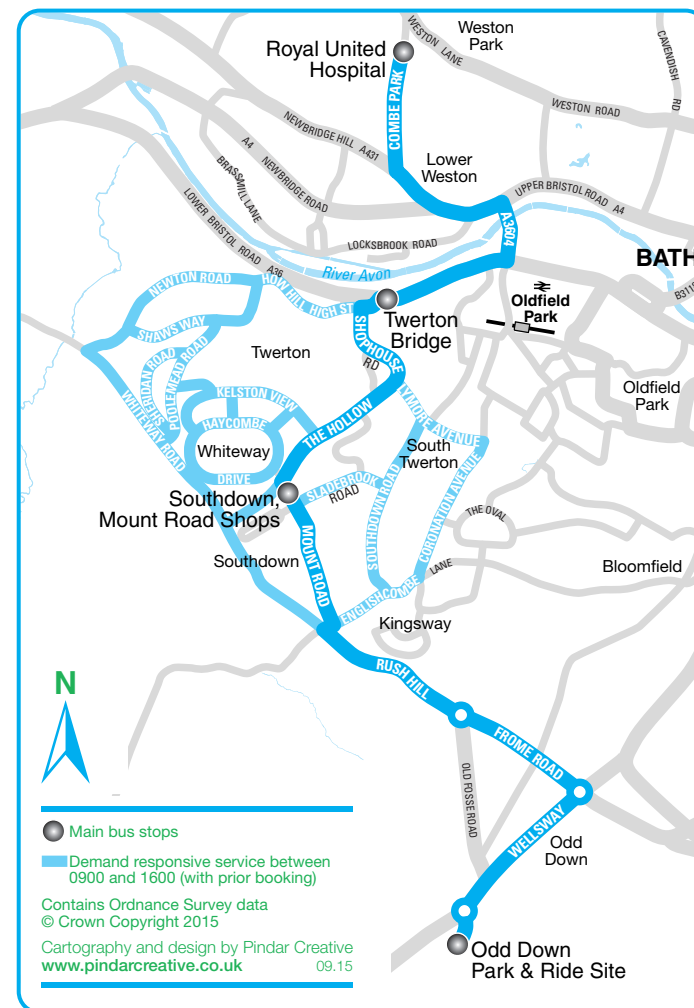
New sQuid smartcard

The stored value **sQuid smartcard** holds a cash balance that can be used to pay for bus travel. The card is available from the driver and can be topped up online or on the bus.

If you pay for a 'smart single' ticket using **sQuid** there is a significant saving on the normal cash price of the ticket.

The balance on your card can be protected in case it is lost or stolen by registering your card with **sQuid**.

Demand Responsive Service

- Between 0900 and 1600 Service 42 operates a flexible demand responsive service for pre-booked passengers in Twerton, Whiteway and Southdown.
- Passengers who are travelling from stops elsewhere on the route (including Odd Down Park & Ride) do **not** need to make advance bookings.

If you would like to be picked up from a stop on the demand-responsive route please telephone **01225 394909** (between 1000 and 1400 Monday to Friday) at least one day before you are due to travel.
