The rural area outside of the City of Bath has a Definitive Map and Statement.

The City of Bath Definitive Map and Statement uses the pre-1966 Bath City boundary.

There are areas in Weston, Lambridge and Combe Down which are outside of the pre-1966 Bath City boundary. These areas are included on the Definitive Map and Statement for the rural area and are not included in the research for the City of Bath Definitive Map and Statement.



Before 2019, the boundaries of the wards in the City of Bath were as shown by the blue outline. The pre-1966 Bath City boundary is shown in red. The following wards have been researched: Weston, Lansdown, Lambridge, Newbridge, Kingsmead, Abbey, River & Towpath paths, Walcot, Bathwick (including a small part of Combe Down, Twerton, Westmoreland, Widcombe and Southdown.

Since 2019, the boundaries of the wards in the City of Bath have been altered, as shown by the red outline. The pre-1966 Bath City boundary is shown in blue. The following wards are still to be researched: Moorlands, parts of Westmoreland, Oldfield Park and Widcombe & Lyncombe, Odd Down and parts of Combe Down.
