We currently have some key tender opportunities to find Contractors who will deliver Bathscape Projects. We are letting contracts in tranches, and the ones currently available are outlined in this table. Guidance on accessing ProContract is included below.

Grassland Restoration Volunteers	£28,000	To lead parties of volunteers to: identify / survey / record species-rich grassland within the Bathscape to build an inventory of priority grassland sites, gauge their current condition and inform management options; enhance and restore species-rich grasslands through a series of regular practical volunteer work days and increase knowledge/ skills. Grassland Stewardship support	£54,000	Under this contract we are seeking an Advisor to work directly with landowners in the Bathscape area whose holdings contain priority grassland habitat and who are eligible for governmental Countryside Stewardship schemes funding. Advisory Service outside stewardship	£65,000	Under this contract we are seeking an Advisor (the contractor) to work with landowners (who are not eligible for governmental stewardship schemes) to upgrade semi-improved grasslands and make positive changes to management. Landscape on prescription practical volunteering	£37,000	The contractor will provide outdoor practical conservation volunteering sessions in the landscape targeted at people from the Twerton, Whiteway and Southdown areas of Bath. The contractor will support people who have been referred by the local GP, or who have self-referred, to take part in activities to improve their physical health and mental wellbeing. Practical volunteering with skills	£31,000	The Contractor will deliver: community events and taster sessions primarily in south west Bath and with priority groups; establish a regular volunteer work party (including a leading role in recruitment) for practical conservation. Accredited training	£20,000	The Contractor will deliver a series of six week programmes (1 day per week), linked to the care and management of the landscape and natural environment, aimed at young people not in education, employment or training.	Friday 15 <sup>th</sup> February	DN387604

On the Home page, in the middle of the screen is a purple box 'Register Now'. If you click on the box you will be taken to a page where you will see a 'New to Portal' box and here you can start the registration process.

*Registration is free. There is no cost to you for using this portal.*

You will be asked for your company details and the type of work you want to be considered for. Complete the information and submit your registration to be enabled to view the B&NES tender document (when it is loaded).

Once you have completed the registration, you can view the tenders on the 'Current Opportunities' list by clicking on the title name of the tender, which appears in blue. If you want to download the documents to complete them, you'll have to click on the green button 'Login and Register Interest in this Opportunity'.

You can find the tenders by searching for 'Bathscape' or by using the DN number in the table above.
