**BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL**  
**ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES (MIDSOMER**  
**NORTON) ORDER 2013**

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") is satisfied that nuisance or annoyance to members of the public, or a section of the public, or disorder have been associated with the consumption of alcohol in the places shown within the boundary edged red on the attached plan.

The Council in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 hereby makes the following Order:

- 1, The places shown within the boundary edged red on the attached plan will be a "designated public place" for the purposes of sections 12-16 of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001.
- 2, This Order shall come into effect on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2013 and may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Places (Midsomer Norton) Order 2013.
