Permanent Traffic Regulation Order Statement of Reasons

Scheme: Various Roads, Bath - (Width Restriction) Order 201*

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

The Council in exercise of their powers under The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 propose to make a permanent Order to introduce a 6'6" width restriction on the entire length of Cavendish Road, Lansdown Crescent, Lansdown Place East, Lansdown Place West and Upper Lansdown Mews, and that part of Sion Hill in Bath.

The scheme is proposed for the following reasons:

- Improve road safety.
- Improve the local environment for residents by reducing the pollution caused by noise and gas emissions.

This order is proposed so as to:

Avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
