

**RECEPTION ADMISSIONS - SEPTEMBER 2025**

**INITIAL ALLOCATION STATEMENT FOR HIGH LITTLETON CHURCH OF  
ENGLAND ACADEMY PRIMARY SCHOOL**

**PLACES AVAILABLE: 29**

As High Littleton Church of England Primary School was oversubscribed it was necessary to use the Academy Trust's admissions criteria, as published in 'A Primary School for Your Child – 2025/26', to allocate the places available at the school. Applications for all schools are considered under an equal preference system which means that all preferences (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>) for each school are considered equally. If there are any cases where more than one of the school preferences named on the application form could have been met only the highest preference school has been allocated.

A total of **52 preferences** were originally received for High Littleton Church of England Academy Primary School which has a published Admission Number of **28**. The Governors/Academy Trust opted to work to a higher Admission Number of **29** for September 2025.

If, under any of the categories listed, places were offered and refused, priority was given to those who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line between the home address and the school.

**How the initial allocation of places was made for this school:**

**0 places have been offered to a child with an Education, Health and Care Plan where the school has been named in their statement**

**Category A** - Looked after children or previously looked after children. **0 Children**

**Category B** – Children who live within the Parish of High Littleton and Hallatrow and for whom there will be a sibling in attendance on the admission date. **9 Children**

**Category C** – Children who live within the Parish of High Littleton and Hallatrow. **9 Children**

**Category D** – Children who live outside the Parish of High Littleton and Hallatrow and for whom there will be a sibling in attendance. **9 Children**

**Category E** - Children who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line. **2 Children. The furthest direct line distance between the preferred school and the home address offered in this category was 0.947 miles.**

**1 child in total has initially been refused a place at High Littleton Church of England Primary School.** (All other preferences originally considered have qualified for another school as a higher preference)
