ALLOCATION STATEMENT FOR EAST HARPTREE PRIMARY SCHOOL

PLACES AVAILABLE: 15

As East Harptree Primary School was oversubscribed it was necessary to use the Academy Trust's admissions criteria, as published in 'A Primary School for Your Child – 2025/26', to allocate the places available at the school. Applications for all schools are considered under an equal preference system which means that all preferences (1st, 2nd & 3rd) for each school are considered equally. If there are any cases where more than one of the school preferences named on the application form could have been met only the highest preference school has been allocated.

A total of **18 preferences** were originally received for East Harptree Primary School which has an Admission Number of **15**.

If, under any of the categories listed, places were offered and refused, priority was given to those who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line between the home address and the school.

How the initial allocation of places was made for this school:

Category A – Children Looked After – Children who are in the care of a Local Authority or have previously been but immediately after being looked after became subject to an adoption, a child arrangement order, or special guardianship order. **0 Children**

Category B – (The 2 categories in this criterion will be given equal consideration). **6 Children**

- Children who live within a 1.5 mile radius* of the school and for whom there will be a sibling in attendance on the admission date at the preferred school.
- Children who live outside a 1.5 mile radius* of the school but it is their closest school and for whom there will be a sibling in attendance on the admission date at the preferred school.

*The 1.5 mile radius is measured from the address point of the school as defined by the Local Land & Property Gazetteer (LLPG)

Category C - Children who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line. **9 Children. The furthest direct line distance between the preferred school and the home address offered in this category was 1.903 miles.**

1 child has initially been refused a place at East Harptree Primary School. (All other preferences originally considered have qualified for another school as a higher preference)

Please Note: If you decide to lodge a formal appeal for a place at this particular school your initial notification of intent to appeal should be sent to your home local authority **by 1 May 2025** and your letter of appeal for East Harptree Primary School should be sent no later than **16 May 2025** by email to: admissions_transport@bathnes.gov.uk or by post: Admissions & Transport, Bath & North East Somerset Council, Lewis House, Manvers Street, Bath BA1 1JG.
