

<u>INFANT TO JUNIOR ADMISSIONS - SEPTEMBER 2025</u>

ALLOCATIONS STATEMENT FOR MOORLANDS JUNIOR SCHOOL

PLACES AVAILABLE: 60

As Moorland Junior School was oversubscribed it was necessary to use the Academy Trust's admissions criteria, as published in 'A Primary School for Your Child' – 2025/26', to allocate the places available at the school. Applications for all schools are considered under an equal preference system which means that all preferences (1st, 2nd & 3rd) for each school are considered equally. If there are any cases where more than one of the school preferences named on the application form could have been met only the highest preference school has been allocated.

A total of **102** preferences were originally received for Moorlands Junior School which has an Admission Number of **60**.

How the initial allocation of places was made for this school:

3 places have been held for children with an Education, Health and Care Plan where the school is being consulted for their plan. These children are included within the Admission Number for the school.

Category A - Looked after child or previously looked after child. 1 Child

Category B - Children transferring from Moorlands Infant School at the end of Year 2. **55 Children**

Category C – Children for whom there will be a sibling in attendance on the admission date at Moorlands Infant or the Junior School. 1 Child. The furthest direct line distance between the midpoint and the home address offered in this category was 0.325 miles.

Category D - Children who live closest to the Junior school as measured in a direct line from the address point of the Junior school. **0** Children

4 children have initially been refused a place at Moorlands Junior School. (All other preferences originally considered have qualified for another school as a higher preference)
