INITIAL ALLOCATION STATEMENT FOR ST. JULIAN'S CHURCH SCHOOL

PLACES AVAILABLE: 16

As St. Julian's Church School was oversubscribed it was necessary to use the Academy Trust's admissions criteria, as published in 'A Primary School for Your Child – 2025/26', to allocate the places available at the school. Applications for all schools are considered under an equal preference system which means that all preferences (1st, 2nd & 3rd) for each school are considered equally. If there are any cases where more than one of the school preferences named on the application form could have been met only the highest preference school has been allocated.

A total of **31 preferences** were originally received St. Julian's Church School which has a published Admission Number of **16.**

Under the scheme the number of 'on time' preferences that required places at St Julian's Church School met the school's admission number of 16.

All the places originally offered on 16 April 2025 have been accepted and therefore, no further places are available to be allocated.
