ALLOCATIONS STATEMENT FOR OLDFIELD PARK JUNIOR SCHOOL

Places Available: 60

As Oldfield Park Junior was oversubscribed it was necessary to use the Academy Trust's admissions criteria as published in 'A Primary School for your Child' to allocate the places available at the school. Applications for all schools have been considered under an equal preference system which means that all preferences (1st, 2nd & 3rd) for each school have been considered equally for places under the Academy Trust's published admissions criteria. If there were any cases where more than one of the school preferences named on the application form could have been met only the highest preference school has been allocated.

A total of **88 preferences** were originally received for Oldfield Park Junior School which has an Admission Number of **60**.

How the initial allocation of places was made for this school:

2 places have been offered for children with an Education, Health and Care Plan and following the appropriate consultation placement at the school has been recommended. These children are included within the Admission Number for the school.

Category A - Looked after child or previously looked after child. **0 Children**

Category B - Children who live within a 1.5 mile radius* of the school and for whom there will be a sibling in attendance at the time of the application. **14 Children**

Category C – At The time of application, the child attends Oldfield Park Infant School. **43 Children.**

Category D – Children who are closest to the midpoint* as measured in a direct line. **1 Child.** The furthest direct line distance between the midpoint and the home address offered in this category was **0.418 miles.**

*For Oldfield Park Infant and Oldfield Park Junior Schools the 1.5 mile radius will be measured from a midpoint between the paired schools. The midpoint is at 29 Maybrick Rd, Bath, BA2 3PU.

1 child has initially been refused a place at Oldfield Park Junior School. (All other preferences originally considered have qualified for another school as a higher preference)
