NOTICE is given that the Bath and North East Somerset Council has made an order on the 8th December 2022 under provisions contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will introduce the following variations to restrictions in **North East Outer Bath area**:-

- 1. Introduce No Parking At Any Time in lengths of Snow Hill, Bedford Street, Weymouth Street, London Road, Bennett Lane, Kensington Gardens, Brunswick Street, Piccadilly Place, Hanover Street, Upper East Hayes, Saffron Court, Long Acre House, Arundel Road, Highbury Place, Gillingham Terrace, Frankley Buildings, Tyning Lane, Chilton Road, Middle Lane, Belgrave Road, Claremont Road, Eastbourne Avenue and Camden Road, Bath.
- 2. Introduce Permit Holders Only, operating between 8am 6pm in lengths of Snow Hill, Bennett Lane, Kensington Gardens, Brunswick Street, Hanover Street, Upper East Hayes, Saffron Court, Long Acre House, Arundel Road, Highbury Place, Gillingham Terrace, Frankley Buildings, Tyning Lane, Chilton Road, Middle Lane, Kensington Place, Beaufort Villas, Belgrave Road, Claremont Road and Eastbourne Avenue, Bath.
- 3. Introduce Permit Holders and 1 hour Limited Waiting, operating between 8am 6pm in lengths of Snow Hill, Weymouth Street, Bedford Street, Tyning Lane, Bath.
- 4. Introduce Disabled Parking in lengths of Chilton Road, Upper East Hayes, Snow Hill and Gillingham Terrace, Bath
- 5. Introduce No Parking Between Times in lengths of London Road, Snow Hill, Weymouth Street and Bedford Street, Bath.
- 6. Introduce 1 hour Limited Waiting, operating between 8am 6pm in lengths of London Road, Camden Road and Snow Hill, Bath.
- 7. Introduce Loading Only in lengths of London Road, Bath.
- 8. Introduce No Waiting and No Loading At Any Time in lengths of London Road and Snow Hill, Bath.

The order will come into operation on 31st July 2023. Full details of the proposal together with a map and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for making the order may be inspected at the One Stop Shops at Manvers Street, Bath, The Hollies, High Street, Midsomer Norton and at the Civic Centre, Market Walk, Keynsham during normal office hours. Any person who desires to question the validity of, or any provision contained in the order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, may within six weeks after the date on which the order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
