

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL

(SOUTHLANDS, WESTON) (BATH) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES)
(PROHIBITION OF PARKING AND WAITING)
(EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2022

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under section 9 and section 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, makes the following Order: -

1. This Order comes into operation on the 17th November 2022 and may be cited as the (Southlands, Weston) (Bath) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Prohibition of Parking and waiting) (Experimental) Order 2022.

2. In this Order:-

“pedal cycle” means a bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels;

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

3. Subject to Article 5, it is prohibited for any vehicle to enter the roads specified in Schedule 1 to this order at any time.

4. Subject to Article 5, it is prohibited for any vehicle to park and/or wait on the length of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this order at any time.

5. Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 shall apply to any Pedal Cycle

SCHEDULE 1

Road

Length

Southlands, Weston

From a point 139 metres south east of its junction with Dean Hill Lane for a distance of 14 metres in an easterly direction.

SCHEDULE 2

Road

Length

Southlands, Weston

From a point 136 metres south east of its junction with Dean Hill Lane on the southern side for a distance of 32 metres in an easterly direction.

From a point 139 metres south east of its junction with Dean Hill Lane extending across the highway from north to south.

From a point 153 metres south east of its junction with Dean Hill Lane extending across the highway from north to south.
