(VARIOUS ROADS, SOUTH EAST OUTER AREA, BATH) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF PARKING AND LOADING) (NO STOPPING ON ENTRANCE MARKINGS) (AUTHORISED AND DESIGNATED PARKING PLACES)
(VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2022

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 51, 53 and 63A of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, makes the following order:-

1. This order comes into operation on the 20th February 2023 and may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Various Roads, South East Outer Area, Bath) (Prohibition and Restriction of Parking and Loading) (No Stopping on Entrance Markings) (Authorised and Designated Parking Places) (Variation No. 1) Order 2022.

VARIATION OF EXISTING ORDERS

2. The Bath and North East Somerset Council (Various Roads, South East Outer Area, Bath) (Prohibition and Restriction of Parking and Loading) (No Stopping on Entrance Markings) (Authorised and Designated Parking Places) Order 2022 is further varied and has effect as though:

(1)the Tile G15 is replaced with the Tile G15 dated in the schedule to this order;
(2)the Tile G16 is replaced with the Tile G16 dated in the schedule to this order;
(3)the Tile G17 is replaced with the Tile G17 dated in the schedule to this order;

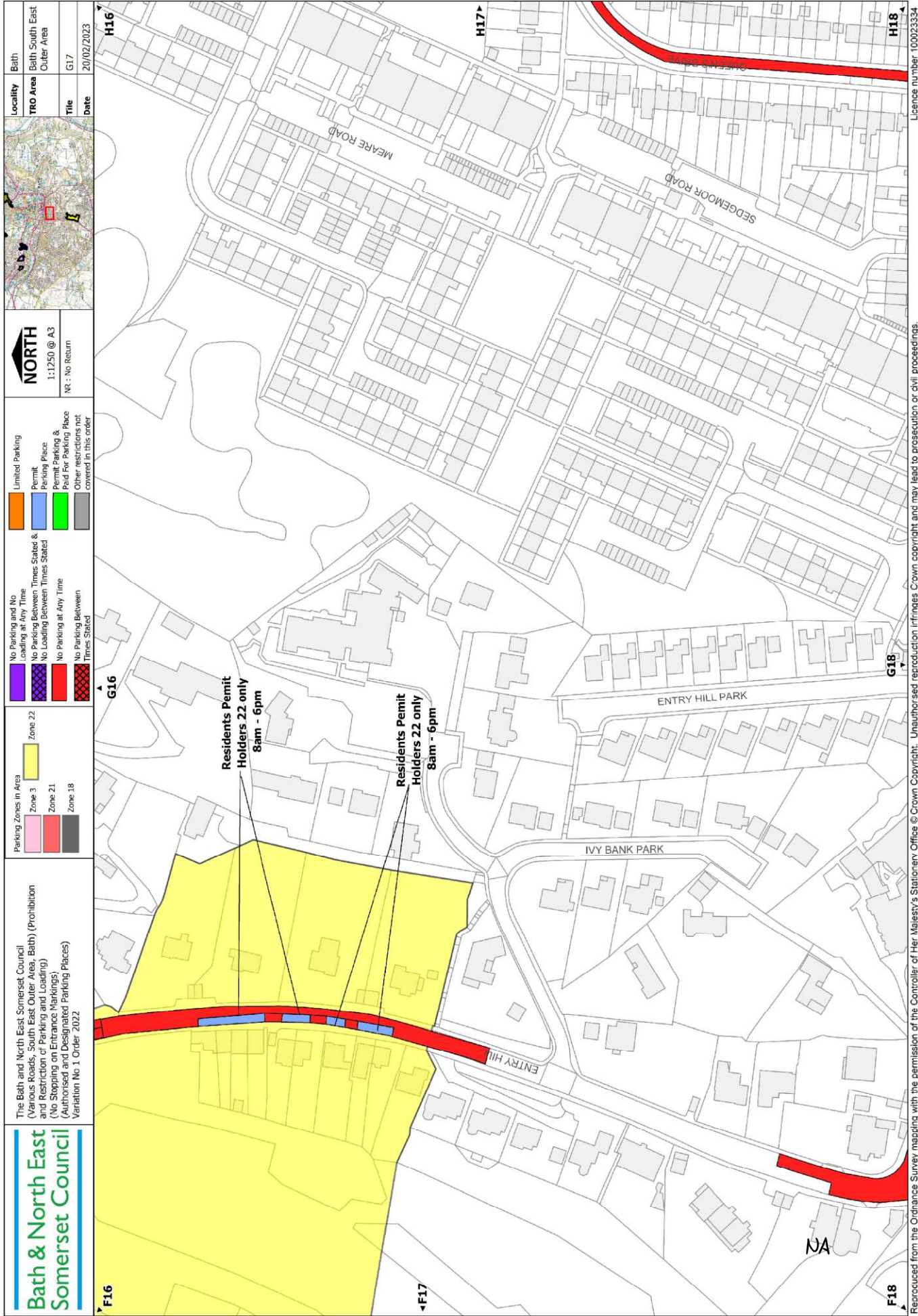
