(KINGSMEAD SQUARE, BATH)

(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF PARKING, LOADING AND WAITING) (AUTHORISED AND DESIGNATED LOADING) ORDER 2023

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 51, 53 and 63A of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, makes the following order:-

This order is being made for reasons (a) and (b) as listed in Section 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which are for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road to which the order relates or any other road, and for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

1. This order comes into operation on the 28th July 2023 and may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Kingsmead Square, Bath) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (One-Way Traffic) (Prohibition and Restriction of Parking, Loading and Waiting) (Authorised and Designated Loading) Order 2023;
2. In this Order:-

“pedal cycle” means a bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels;

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

3. Subject to Article 5, it is prohibited for any vehicle to enter the roads specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 from the roads specified in the corresponding column 2, between 11.00 a.m. and midnight. A gate or barrier will prevent access during this time and can only be operated by a person with the permission of the Local Authority or under the direction of a police officer in uniform, a traffic warden or a Civil Enforcement Officer (CEO).

One-Way Traffic

4. Subject to Article 5, a vehicle must not enter or proceed in the lengths of road specified in column 1 of the schedule, other than in the direction specified in the corresponding column 2.
5. Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 applies to:
 - (1) Any pedal cycle;
 - (2) Emergency service vehicles;
 - (3) A vehicle being directed by a police constable in uniform.
 - (4) A vehicle to wait whilst any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged is being opened or closed, if it is not reasonably practicable for the vehicle to wait outside otherwise than in a length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order while such gate or other barrier is being opened or closed.

Consolidation of Existing Orders

6. The Orders listed in Schedule 3 are revoked.
7. The Orders listed in Schedule 4 are varied.

Road on the west side of KINGSMEAD SQUARE	New Street
Road on the north side of KINGSMEAD SQUARE	Road on the west side of Kingsmead Square
Road on the east side of KINGSMEAD SQUARE	Road on the north side of Kingsmead Square
AVON STREET between its junction with the road on the east side of Kingsmead Square and its junction with James Street West	Road on the east side of Kingsmead Square

SCHEDULE 2
One-Way Traffic

Roads and Lengths of Road 1	Direction 2
Road on the west side of KINGSMEAD SQUARE	From New Street towards the road on the north side of Kingsmead Square
Road on the north side of KINGSMEAD SQUARE	From the road on the west side of Kingsmead Square towards the road on the east side of Kingsmead Square
Road on the east side of KINGSMEAD SQUARE	From the road on the north side of Kingsmead Square towards Avon Street
AVON STREET between its junction with the road on the east side of Kingsmead Square and its junction with James Street West	From the road on the east side of Kingsmead Square towards James Street West
