

**BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL**

**(QUEEN CHARLTON LANE, QUEEN CHARLTON) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2024**

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under section 9 and section 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, makes the following Order: -

1. This Order comes into operation on the 18<sup>th</sup> May 2024 and may be cited as the (Queen Charlton Lane, Queen Charlton) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 2024.
2. In this Order:-

“pedal cycle” means a bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels;

**Prohibition of Motor Vehicles**

3. Subject to Article 4, it is prohibited for any vehicle to enter the roads specified in Schedule 1 to this order at any time.
4. Nothing in Articles 3 shall apply to any
  - a) any emergency service vehicle; or
  - b) any pedal cycle; or
  - c) any vehicle being used for the purpose of agriculture or land management on any land or premises adjacent to that road; and
  - d) any vehicle being directed by a Police Constable in uniform.

**Road**

**Length**

Queen Charlton Lane

From a point 400 metres east of its junction with Woollard Lane extending for a distance of 1005 metres in an easterly direction.
