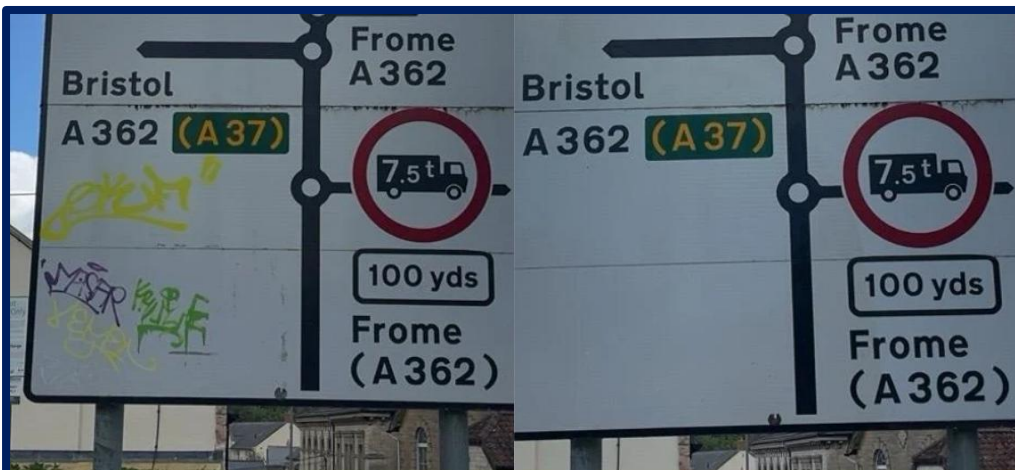

## Highway Maintenance and Drainage

Highway Services have continued to carry out essential maintenance of the district's drainage systems through routine gully inspections and cleaning. During April, 3002 gullies were inspected and 2780 were cleaned, helping to maintain effective water flow across the network. This activity continued in May, with a further 2523 gullies inspected and 2380 cleaned, reinforcing our ongoing commitment to keeping the drainage system functioning efficiently.
