From 1 February to 31 March, the clean and green team resolved 112 reported cases, including sweeping, weeding and litter removal.

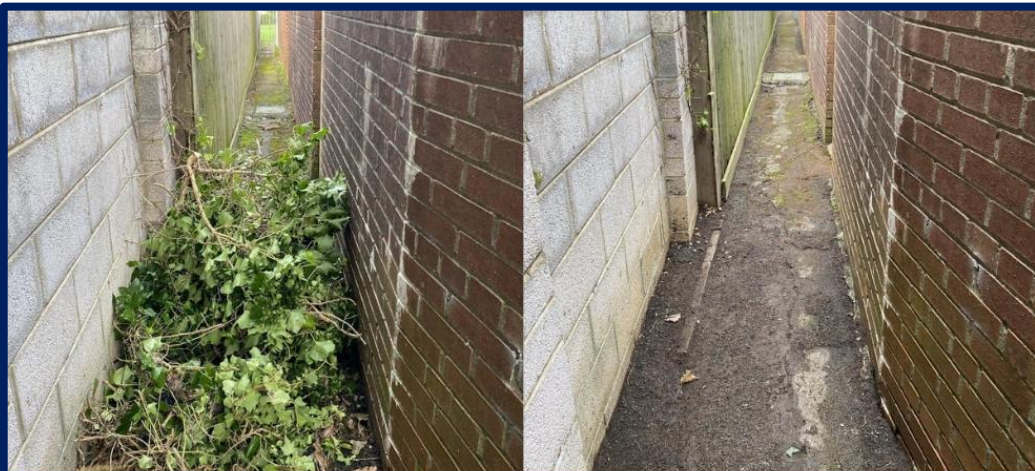

## Highway Maintenance and Drainage

Highway Services have continued their essential work to maintain the district's drainage systems, undertaking routine gully inspections and cleaning. In February 1284 gullies were inspected and 1238 cleaned, supporting effective water flow across the network. In March, a further 2188 gullies were inspected and 2053 cleaned, reflecting our ongoing commitment to keep the drainage system working effectively.
