

Football Cage Installation – Royal Victoria Park

Organisation:

Bath City Youth Football Club (Community Association Sports Club - CASC)

Bath & North East Somerset Council (funding recipient and delivery body)

Funding Requested:

£45,000 from the Bath Neighbourhood Portion of CIL

(Total project cost: £44,718.60 including VAT)

Project Description:

The project proposes the construction of a multi-use enclosed football cage in Victoria Park, Bath. It will provide a safe, free-to-access space for informal football, particularly benefiting children and young people from surrounding residential areas. The cage will formalise an already informally used area, improving safety and accessibility.

Procurement and installation: Managed by Bath & North East Somerset Council

Community engagement: Led by Bath City Youth FC

Maintenance: Minimal, limited to safety inspections

Key Outcomes:

Increased access to informal sport for children of all backgrounds

Enhanced youth wellbeing and physical activity

A scalable model for future youth engagement projects
