

Lambridge Pedestrian Safety Improvements

Project Description:

This project aims to improve pedestrian safety at two key junctions in Lambridge and Larkhall:

Worcester Buildings / Avondale Buildings / Charlcombe Lane

Installation of a raised pedestrian crossing to slow traffic and improve visibility, especially for school children and families.

Eldon Place / Charlcombe Lane

Introduction of traffic calming measures to reduce vehicle speeds and improve safety near an existing zebra crossing.

These improvements will support safer access to St Saviour's Infant and Junior Schools, St Mark's Secondary School, and other community amenities.

Key Outcomes:

Safer crossings for over 630 school children, families, and older residents

Reduced vehicle speeds and improved pedestrian visibility

Increased walking and wheeling, supporting healthier lifestyles

Enhanced access to schools, shops, parks, and community spaces
