

# Moorland Road Community Library Refurbishment and Infrastructure Upgrade

## Organisation:

Moorland Road Community Library (Charity no. 1179729)

## Funding Requested:

£13,500 from the Bath Neighbourhood Portion of CIL

(No matched funding secured)

## Project Description:

The project aims to update furnishings, fittings, and technology at Moorland Road Community Library to create a more welcoming, accessible, and functional environment for users and volunteers. The library serves over 1,000 registered users and is entirely volunteer-run.

## Proposed Improvements:

Replace worn flooring (especially in the children's area)

Install new storage units for craft materials and seasonal items

Upgrade the volunteer desk to a two-station unit with integrated cabling

Replace outdated IT equipment (computers, monitors, printer)

Improve shelf signage for easier navigation

Add child-friendly book storage solutions

## Key Outcomes:

Enhanced user experience and accessibility

Increased footfall and community engagement

Expanded services (e.g. book clubs, craft sessions, community meetings)

Continued provision of local library services without the need to travel into central Bath
