# Sydney Gardens Reservoir Preservation Project

#### Organisation:

Friends of Sydney Gardens – a constituted volunteer group established in 2013, with over 150 members, dedicated to preserving and enhancing Sydney Gardens for public benefit.

### Funding Requested:

£18,500 from the Bath Neighbourhood Portion of CIL

(Total project cost: £28,279, with £10,000 already raised by the Friends)

#### **Project Description:**

The project aims to restore and secure the historic reservoir entrances in Sydney Gardens, improving public safety, heritage interpretation, and landscaping. Works include:

Stabilising tufa stones around both entrances

Replacing red bricks with reclaimed Bath stone

Repairing stone steps to meet safety standards

Installing metal railings and padlocked iron-barred gates

Adding a visitor interpretation board

Landscaping the surrounding grass area

Enhanced visitor experience and historical awareness

Reduced maintenance burden for the park

Increased community engagement and pride
