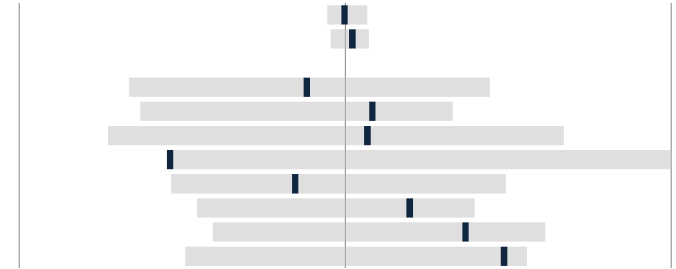
The line down the centre is the B&NES average
