The dark line represents this local area. If it is on this side, the % is less than average.

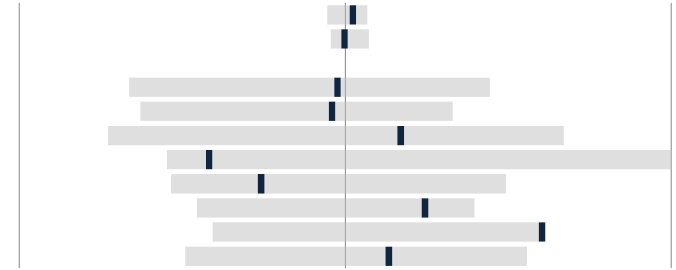
The line down the centre is the B&NES average.

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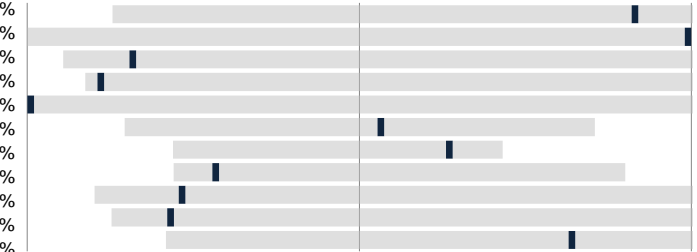
