The dark line represents this local area. If it is on this side, the % is less than average

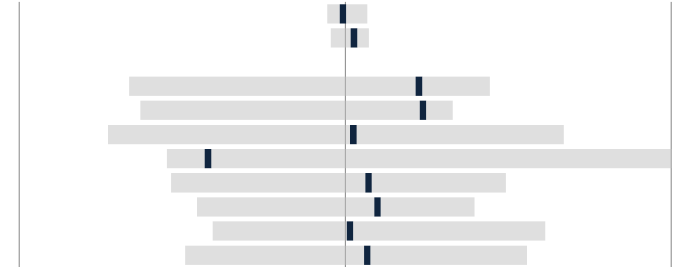
