If it is on this side, the % is less than average

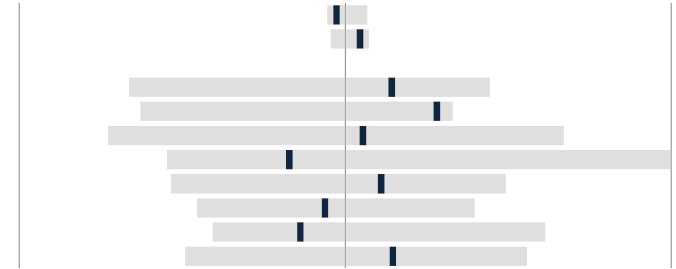
The line down the centre is the B&NES average

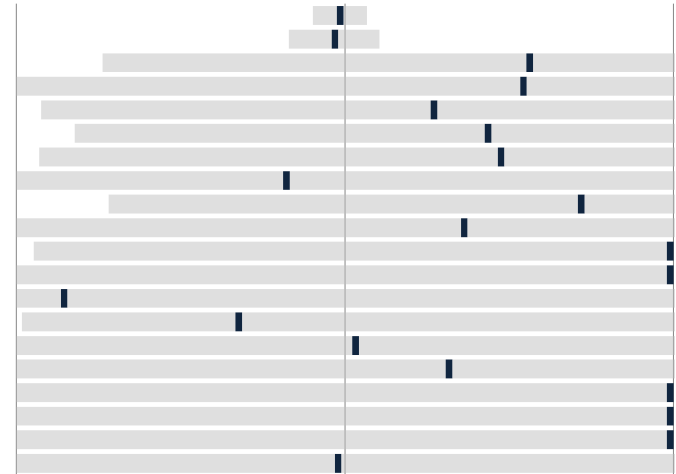

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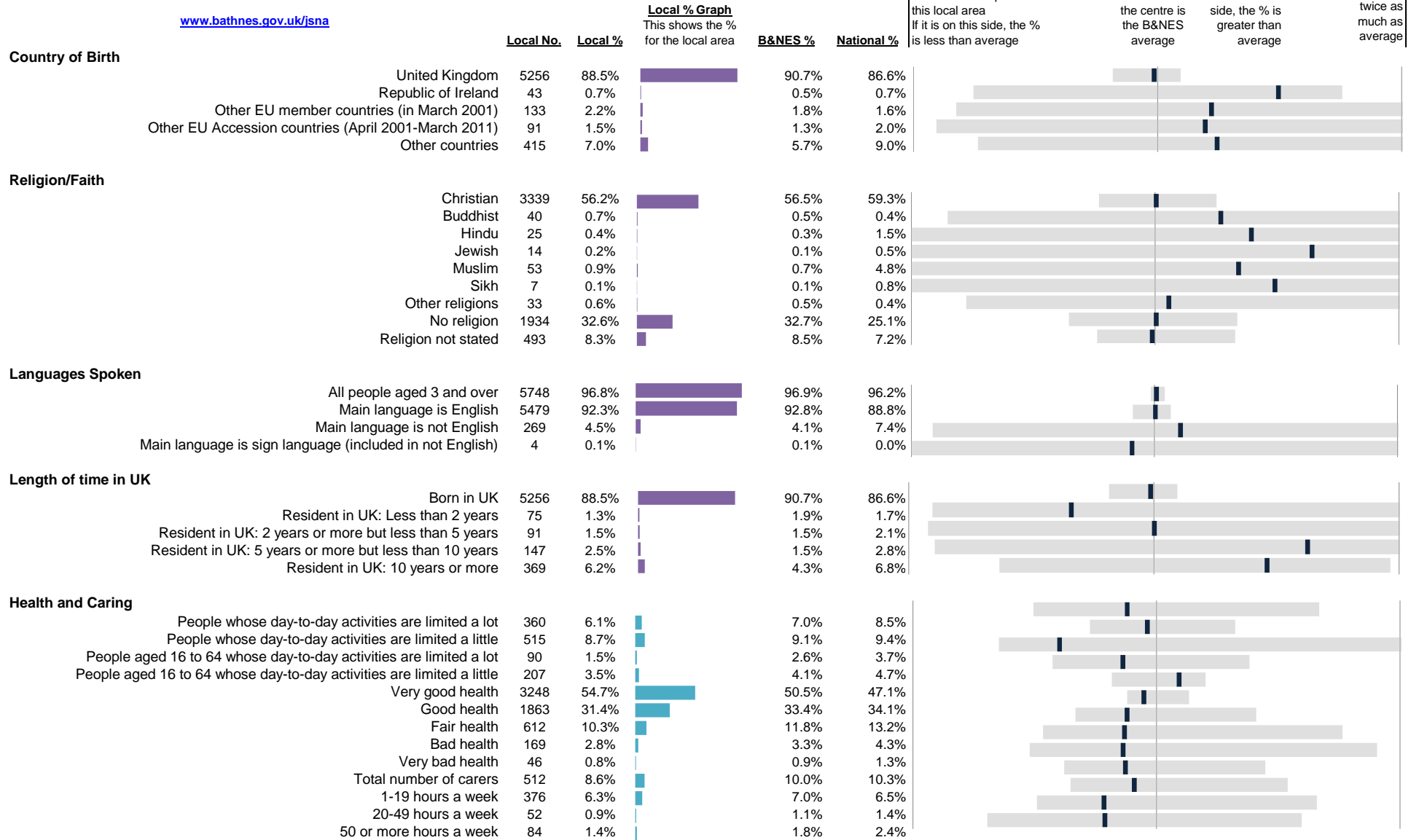
Comparison Graph - This graph compares the local area to B&NES

The line down the centre is the B&NES average

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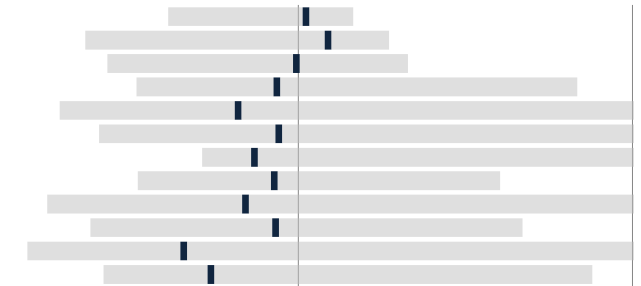
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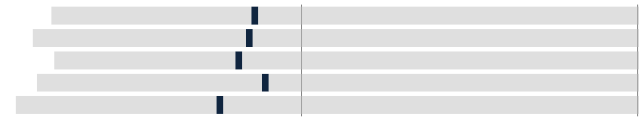
