Which Environment Agency Flood Warnings are you registered to receive?

(You can [sign up for flood warnings](https://www.gov.uk/sign-up-for-flood-warnings) at <https://www.gov.uk/sign-up-for-flood-warnings>).

You'll need to provide:

- the address you're registering
- a phone number you can be contacted on day or night
- an email address

The service is free. You can get warnings by phone, email or text message.

Local Flood Warning Triggers

i.e. when flood water reaches bottom of the bridge, sound siren or other action

Contents of Community Flood Plan Annex:

- 6.1 Map showing flood risk areas and direction of flooding
- 6.2 Actions to be taken before, during and after a flood
- 6.3 After a flood: reputable contractors

Emergency Community Contacts

They will help coordinate response in the community and they will liaise with the emergency services and local authority.

- Know who your Emergency Community Contacts are
- Have a home emergency plan for you and your family
- Know where your closest place of safety is

Prepare an Emergency Preparedness Kit

- Torch/battery powered lantern
- A list of key contacts, phone numbers/addresses
- First aid kit
- Bottle of water/snacks
- Phone charger/portable battery charger

Don't forget to plan for your pets!

- Food & water for a few days
- Travel carrier
- Pet & vet documentation




