Terms and Conditions

- The competition runs from 18 April 30 June 2016. You can take part at any time within that period and you can arrange more than one collection if you wish.
- *The winning school will be invited to visit BTR between 11 15 July. If you need to arrange an alternative date, please contact us in advance.
- The competition is open to any primary (including Infant and Junior), secondary or special school within the boundaries of Bath & North East Somerset. This excludes the 5 schools that are taking part in the Resource Futures textile project who will have access to their own competition.
- You can use any company to collect your textiles you do not have to use BTR. Whoever you choose must be able to provide evidence, if needed, that the textiles will be re-used or recycled.
- You will need to submit a receipt (or copy) detailing the weight of textiles collected.
- Receipts should only be for textiles collected between 18 April 2016 30 June 2016.
- When submitting your receipt, please include the following information name of school, contact person and contact details, number of pupils, date and
 weight of textiles collected and details of the company collecting them. Contact
 details will be used for clarifications and to contact the winner. We may wish
 to contact you about future recycling campaigns with your agreement.
- Please send your receipt and additional information by email to wastecampaigns@bathnes.gov.uk entitled: School Textile Recycling Competition. Alternatively you can post them to us at: School Textile Recycling Competition, Waste Services, Lewis House, Manvers Street, Bath, BA1 1JG. Entries must arrive before 30 June 2016.
- The Council reserves the right to amend the prize or withdraw the competition at any time.
- The prize consists of a morning visit to the Bristol Textile Recyclers factory in Bristol. Schools will be responsible for organising their own transport and providing enough adults to accompany the visit (minimum 2 adults per 10 pupils)
- Access at the factory is limited for those with mobility impairments, in particular wheelchair users. The winning school may visit the factory to examine the access restrictions and conduct their own risk assessment if there are likely to be issues of access or safety regarding individual pupils.
- The winning school must consent to taking part in the Council's publicity about the event.
