
Thank you for your consultation and amended plans regarding the above proposal.

The National Rivers Authority - South Western Region has no objection in principle to this proposed development, however we would make the following comments:

The development and its operation should be such that there is no risk of pollution from the escape of chemicals and materials.

Although provisions are made in the scheme for bunding and proper storage of materials, additionally there must be adequate protection to minimise risks from the drip storage areas and any storage and holding area for treated timber. They should be in an area of total containment. Bund constructions should also be protected from vehicle accident damage. We would request a condition be imposed on any planning permission to the effect that bunding details should be provided and agreed by your authority prior to the construction of the plant.

The misuse of chemicals involved in Timber Treatment Plants can have dire consequences for the environment if handled and stored incorrectly. The recommendations of Code of Practice for the Safe Design and Operation of Timber Treatment Plants be adhered to. A copy of the Code issued by the British Wood Preserving and Damp Proofing Association is enclosed and additional draft Guidance Notes on the construction and the use of timber plants is currently being prepared by Her Majestys Inspector of Pollution. Your Chief Environmental Health Officer is likely to have a copy and give advice.
