

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL

(UPPER BRISTOL ROAD, BATH) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC MANDATORY CYCLE LANE) (ORDER 2022)

NOTICE is given that the Bath and North East Somerset Council has made an order under provisions contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will introduce the following variations to restrictions in **Upper Bristol Road, Bath:-**

1. Introduce a mandatory Cycle Lane in that length of Upper Bristol Road, Bath, on the north side of the road between its junction with Charlotte Street and a point 20 metres east of its junction with Midland Road and on the south side of the road 10 metres west from its junction with Charlotte Street and a point 20 metres east of its junction with Midland Road, which is bounded on the north and south side kerblines of that road.

The order will come into operation on **1st August 2022** Full details, together with a map and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for making the order, may be requested, free of charge, by contacting by email council_connect@bathnes.gov.uk. Any person who desires to question the validity of, or any provision contained in the order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, may within six weeks after the date on which the order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
