

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL

**(BECKFORD ROAD, BATH) (MANDATORY CYCLE LANE) (ORDER 2022)**

NOTICE is given that the Bath and North East Somerset Council has made an order under provisions contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will introduce the following variations to restrictions in **Beckford Road, Bath:-**

1. Introduce a mandatory Cycle Lane in that length of Beckford Road, Bath, which extends from its junction with Bathwick Street in a north-eastern and eastern direction to its junction with Warminster Road, which is bounded on the north west and north side kerblines of that road.

The order will come into operation on **1<sup>st</sup> August 2022**. Any person who desires to question the validity of, or any provision contained in the order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, may within six weeks after the date on which the order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
