

Keynsham Recycling Hub



Welcome to the latest newsletter for the Keynsham Recycling Hub which will keep you up to date with progress on the construction phase of the project.

Works continue on site at Pixash Lane, Keynsham on the development of the Council's new recycling hub with the expected completion in Autumn 2023 when the new hub will be fully operational. Following clearance and preparation of the whole site things have really started to take shape. Work has progressed to install the foundations and steel structure for the recycling centre buildings.

A programme of works has been completed by a range of utility companies to ensure the new facility has adequate supplies such as power and water. At the same time the utility companies are taking the opportunity to upgrade networks to future proof infrastructure for the wider area.

World's End Lane is being widened and upgraded with a new pavement and two-lane cycle path. This will accommodate traffic to the new recycling hub and improve access for the nearby homes and businesses.

Phase one of the construction is expected to be completed in early 2023, ready for the public recycling centre to move across.

Careers Fair & Employability Day, Oldfield School, Bath

Oldfield School in Bath organised a careers fair with a range of local employers and universities in attendance. They later organised an employability day to help the young people with interview skills in readiness for their future.
