WHO ARE WE?

The Family Intervention Team work alongside social workers to promote successful family relationships. We consider the individual needs of each family member with the aim of reducing risk and preventing family breakdown.

Our team consists of:

- Attachment work promoting good parent/child relationships

HOW TO GET IN TOUCH?

To access Family Support, One-to-one Parenting, HSB and Family Group Conferences: A referral must be made to our Duty Team from your child's school, GP, health visitor or other professional. If the referral meets the criteria of the Social Care Single Assessment then one of our workers will be in contact you to arrange an introductory visit.

If you already have an allocated social worker the referral can be made direct by them.

Referrals for New Way, Stepping Stones and Footprints can be made direct to the relevant manager.

WHAT WILL WE ASK OF YOU?

- We expect to work together
- We expect to all communicate effectively and honestly
- We expect you to be part of the plan to achieve and maintain change

- We will review the plan at least every 12 weeks to ensure that our work is effective
