



A Guide to Searching for Tree Preservation Orders using the website.

1. Open the Tree Preservation Order mapping website.

2. Enter the 'Post Code' or 'Street Name' in the 'Search for a location' box and click the Find button.



3. The 'Tree Preservation Orders' category will be ticked, if you need to check whether a tree is in a 'Conservation Area' tick the box.
