NAMING OF STREET IN HIGH LITTLETON

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that on or after 13th January 2020, BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL will make an order (hereinafter referred to as ‘the Order’) under Section 18 of the Public Health Act 1925. The effect of the Order will be to name the path indicated on the attached plan ‘**THE DRUNG**’.

Any person aggrieved by the intended order may within 21 days after the date of this notice appeal to Bath and Wansdyke Magistrates’ Court at North Parade Road, Bath, BA1 5AF.

Note: The Public Health Act 1875 defines a “street” to include “any highway and any public bridge, and any road lane footway square court alley or passage whether a thoroughfare or not”
