Our promises

When we meet with a child or young person, we will keep these five promises:

- respect you for who you are
- listen to what you say
- share our decisions with you
- help you understand decisions that we make
- let you know what will happen next

Your rights

Children and young people have five rights to help them feel more confident to ask questions of the adults working with them. These are:

- to be treated fairly
- to have a say
- to make some choices
- to information you can understand
- to know how your views were used
