
Police Report for Somer Valley Area Forum – Ending February 2024

This report relates to Midsomer Norton, Radstock, Westfield, Clandown, Writhlington, Peasdown St John, Farmborough, High Littleton and Haydon

Crime Statistics for Past 3 Months



There was a total of **598 offences** reported in this 3-month period. The reports were made by direct contact to the police by using 999, 101 or E-mail. This has decreased from the previous 3 three months by 42 reported incidents.

Violence Against the Person = 262. This offence group includes physical assaults, threats, harassment, controlling or coercive behaviour and stalking.

Theft = 103. This covers a variety of theft types, including making off without payment (bilking), bicycle theft, blackmail and theft other.

Public Order Offences = 59. These offences included verbal abuse, threats of violence.

Vehicle Offences = 50. This includes thefts from vehicles, thefts of vehicles, and offence of vehicle interference.

Arson and Criminal Damage = 38. This offence group included damage to a vehicle and damage to other.

Burglary = 27. This offence group includes residential break in's and attempt breaks and commercial breaks also other (outbuildings).

Sexual offences = 19. This offence group includes allegations of rape of persons over the age of sixteen. Also under the age of 16 and sexual activity with a child and allegation of exposure/voyeurism.

Drug Offences = 13. This group of offences relate to possession of class A and class B drugs.

Fraud = 5 These offences include on line fraud offences.

Miscellaneous Crimes Against Society = 4. This offence group includes is one allegation of perverting the course of justice.

Possession of weapons = 2. This offence group is related to a firearms offence and possession of other offensive weapons.

Robbery = 2. This offence group includes robbery whereby force was threatened or used to commit the offence of theft.

Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) Statistics for Past 3 Months

There were 242 incidents classified as ASB. This has decreased by 65 from the previous 3- month period. These reports can often be duplicates of crimes that have been reported, where in addition to being a crime the incident is also ASB related. The ASB classification covers a variety of incidents, including nuisance behaviour, neighbour disputes, highway disruption, and road traffic related offences.
