

**BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL**

**(PENNYQUICK, WHITEWAY ROAD, RUSH HILL AND FROME ROAD, BATH)  
(18T HEAVY GOODS VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMIT) ORDER 2026**

NOTICE is given that on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2026 the Bath and North East Somerset Council made the following order under provisions contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be that it is prohibited to drive a motor vehicle of a weight exceeding 18 tonnes on the length of Pennyquick, Whiteway Road, Rush Hill and Frome Road, Bath from its junction with A4 Bristol Road extending to its junction with A367 Wellsway.

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (Pennyquick, Whiteway Road, Rush Hill and Frome Road, Bath) (18t Heavy Goods Vehicle Weight Limit) Order 2026 will come into operation on 01<sup>st</sup> May 2026 and a copy, together with a map and a Statement of the Council's reasons for making the order may be inspected, free of charge, at The One Stop Shops at The Hollies, High Street, Midsomer Norton, 3-4 Manvers Street, Bath and at the Keynsham Civic Centre, Market Walk, Keynsham during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or any provision contained in the order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, may within six weeks after the date on which the order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
