



NOTICE is given that the Bath and North East Somerset Council proposes to make an order under provisions contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will prohibit a motor vehicle from driving at speeds exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of roads as shown on plan 1 and speeds exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of roads as shown on the plan 2 & 3.


