(25-042) (PENNYQUICK, WHITEWAY ROAD, RUSH HILL AND FROME ROAD, BATH)

(18T HEAVY GOODS VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMIT) ORDER 2026

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, makes the following order: -

Part 1: Implementation and Citation

1. This order is made on the 12th March 2026 and shall come into operation on the 01st May 2026 and may be cited as (25-042) (Pennyquick, Whiteway Road, Rush Hill and Frome Road, Bath) (18t Heavy Goods Vehicle Weight Limit) Order 2026.
2. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.

Part 2: Additions, Revocations and Modifications

1. The Bath and North East Somerset Council (Various Roads) (Weight Restrictions) (Consolidation) Order 2025 (as amended) is varied as provided by the following plans attached to schedule 1 in this Order.
